- PROGRAM:** We desire to serve you so that your goals for your time at camp might be realized. Options in the summer months: rock climbing/rappelling, mountain biking, hiking, caving, white water canoeing, camping, wilderness survival training, Tyrolean traverse, lake canoeing. In the winter months: ice climbing, rappelling, winter survival training.
- SAFETY:** Safety is a high value for us. Our staff is continually upgrading their training to ensure the safety of our clients. It is imperative that as a participant in our programs you listen and follow the instructions given. Participant age range: 11 years old to adult.
- MEALS:** Our meals are carefully planned to ensure that you are eating a well-balanced diet that meets the needs of your day. Please let us know of any special dietary needs or allergies ahead of time.
- SNACKS:** Please do not bring any snacks containing nuts or have any labeling stating 'may contain nuts. We are a nut-free facility
- SMOKING:** Due to our insurance policy, we do not allow smoking in any of our buildings. For fire safety precautions' smoking is only allowed in designated outdoor areas.
- ALCOHOL/
DRUGS:** Frontier Lodge is a dry facility. Please do not bring alcohol or non-prescription drugs on the property.

LOCATION: Frontier Lodge is located 5 km west of Nordegg (approximately 96 km, 1 hr. driving time, west of Rocky Mountain House, AB) on Highway #11. Turn south following the signs to Frontier Lodge which is at the same entrance as "Fish Lake Recreation Area," and follow the road to the end (approx. 2.5 km). FRONTIER LODGE REFUND POLICY

Summer Camps or other Frontier Courses and Events:

Deposit – Minimum of 50% of total camp fee including GST due with registration.

Final Payment – Payment of the remaining balance (if any) is due at arrival for the camp, course or event.

Cancellation Policy –

- 30 or more days before the start of camp or with a physician's order, all but \$50 is refundable.
- Less than 30 days before the start of camp, all but \$100 or the 50% deposit (whichever is less) is refundable.

Substitutes are not permitted. No refunds will be made for dismissals due to disciplinary action, late arrivals or early departures.
